1. TELL GOD _____

2. PRAISE GOD _____

Job said, *“I was born with nothing, and I’ll die with nothing. The Lord gave, and now He has taken away. May His name be praised! In spite of everything that had happened, Job did not sin by blaming God.” Job 1:21-22 (TEV)*
