3.	ACKNOWLEDGE
	"Each person must be responsible for himself." Gal. 6:5 (NCV)
	"For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." Rom. 3:23 (NIV)
4.	ALLOW
	"You must <u>make allowance for each other's faults</u> and forgive the person who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." Col. 3:13 (NLT)
5.	ADJUST
	"Look out for one another's interests, not just your own." Phil. 2:4 (GN)

6.	ABANDON
